

1 Q. Now, first, of course, I gather you didn't know
2 whether he did or he didn't, did you?

3 A. I can't say that I knew that.

4 Q. All right. But is it your testimony that in
5 reading the materials that were given to you, you never saw
6 any indication of Witness Lee saying he was taking counsel?

7 A. If I had seen that then I would have raised the
8 question about the statement so I must not have seen it.

9 Q. Let me show you -- could I ask you to look at
10 Exhibit 34 and if you will turn to the page -- the numbers
11 down at the bottom there that says 131.

12 A. [Witness complies.] 020131?

13 Q. Yes, sir.

14 MR. SLABACH: Would you refresh my recollection.
15 This is Wallerstedt's manuscript.

16 MR. MORGAN: Correct.

17 MR. SLABACH: Okay.

18 MR. MORGAN: Q. Okay. And for the record, that's
19 Exhibit 34.41.

20 Now, I am going to ask you to read the very first
21 paragraph at the top of the page?

22 A. "For many years I have" --

23 Q. No, you don't have to read it outloud, if you
24 want to read it outloud feel free to.

25 A. [Examination of documents.]

26 Q. All right. Now, does that -- first, do you
27 recognize what that's -- that's written at the top of page
28 -- Exhibit 34.41?

1 A. Well, it's a citation from VGB which is what?
2 Vision of God's Building, I suppose.

3 Q. All right. That's one of Witness Lee's
4 writings, isn't it?

5 A. Yes.

6 Q. Okay. Now when Witness Lee says, "For many
7 years I've never dared to act in an individualistic way.
8 Praise the Lord, under his authority I've always had some
9 brother or sister to match me. We must be matched with
10 others. Whenever you begin to turn you must speak
11 fellowship and confirmation from your brother. Go to him
12 and ask whether or not he agrees with what you're doing.
13 If he does not then you must not turn."

14 Mr. Buckley, would you agree that that's taking
15 counsel?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. So would you agree, sir, that the statement on
18 page 23 of the God-Men I, where it says "Nowhere does he
19 talk of taking counsel" is false?

20 A. Yes.

21 Q. All right. Now Mr. Buckley, you knew that when
22 you wrote it, didn't you?

23 A. I don't remember if I did, but it is there in
24 Mr. Wallerstedt's manuscript.

25 Q. And you read his manuscript, didn't you?

26 A. Yes, I did.

27 Q. So wouldn't you agree that when you allowed
28 that statement "Nowhere does he talk of taking counsel" to
