20 Were you intending to convey to the reader, any  
21 connection between Witness Lee's teachings and the lack of  
22 forthrightness that you charge in the book?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. All right. What was it you were intending to  
25 convey, as far as the connection between Witness Lee's  
26 teaching, and the lack of forthrightness that you charge in

1 the book?

2 A. That Mr. Lee's soteriology on sanctification  
3 theories in practice with pastoral theology will permit and  
4 allow for instances of a lack of forthrightness.

5 Q. Okay. And again you'd forgive me, Mr. Duddy,  
6 but I have to bring all those fancy words down to my level.

7 Are you saying to the jury, that it was your  
8 intention to convey to the readers that Witness Lee's  
9 teachings will allow a person, who wants to follow his  
10 teachings, to conclude that he could be a liar or be  
11 deceitful and still be a good Christian within  
12 Witness Lee's concept?

13 A. That is correct.

14 Q. Okay. Was it also your intention to convey to  
15 the readers of the book, that Witness Lee's teachings would  
16 allow one who follows those teachings to engage in some  
17 form of sexual assault, including rape, and still regard  
18 himself as a good Christian under Witness Lee's teaching?

19 A. That is correct.

20 Q. Okay. And you put in your manuscript at  
21 page -- in Exhibit 405 an incident of a sexual assault that  
22 you represented was brought about, in some way, by  
23 Witness Lee's teaching; is that correct?
