Dear Mr. Robeck;

This letter is to confirm our conversations and to petition the Academic Affairs Committee concerning being readmitted to Fuller Seminary.

I attended Fuller Seminary from 1960-63 and completed 90 quarter hours of work. More than 35 of these hours were done in the areas of Biblical Studies, Theology, and Church History. The remaining hours were in the areas of Ministry, Biblical Languages, and various electives. At the end of my third year, I terminated my studies because of various domestic and personal reasons.

Since 1963 up to the present I have been engaged in full time ministry. The details of which I have explained in my recent application for the M.A. degree.

My plans at the present are to enter the Th.M. program in the field of Historical Theology under Dr. Bromiley. In discussing this with him, he suggested I finish an M.A. degree and complete the courses needed with a total G.P.A. of 3.0 in order to qualify for consideration into the Th.M. program.

Since I have been away from the Seminary for more than seven years I would like to petition the Academic Affairs Committee to be received back with full credit for the 90 quarter hours I completed at Fuller towards an M.A. in Theology. I need six quarter hours to complete the M.A. degree.

Following the completion of the M.A. degree, I need to take the following courses to complete the requirements for application into the Th.M. program: Hermeneutics; N.T. II, Epistles; O.T. III, Writings; Church History III; Ethics and Hebrew. I would continue as an unclassified student while making up these courses.
