Dear Bill,

Your application for admission to Fuller Theological Seminary has been reviewed by our Admissions Committee. Unfortunately, your grade point average while you were previously a student here at Fuller is below the minimum required for admission into the Master of Arts program and we are not able to accept you into that program at this time. However, since you have already been a student at Fuller (and are, therefore, an alumnus), and in view of your report that a problematic family relationship contributed to your poor academic record, we will accept you as a special student on probation for the period of one year (11 courses), or for however long it is necessary to bring your grade point average up to 2.50. You may then reapply to the Master of Arts program and the Admissions Committee will again review your file. Full acceptance for the M.A. program--with no implicit commitment of eventual acceptance into the Th.M. program (which you have indicated is your ultimate goal)--is contingent upon solid academic performance.

Although we have been able to review your file without your G.R.E. scores, they will be needed before your application is complete. We are using these scores for testing purposes only, and they will in no way affect your admissions here. Thank you for your cooperation in registering for this test.


As written in the catalog, we will need to have you pay a fifty dollar matriculation fee within thirty days from the time you are accepted. This money will be applied to your account here to help with the tuition charges for the Fall Quarter. Failure to pay this fee within the time stated may result in a cancellation of the acceptance so that vacancies in the class may be filled from waiting applications.
