2 A HE IS SAYING A COUPLE OF THINGS.

3 NUMBER ONE, HE IS SAYING THAT "FORGET FOR A MOMENT THAT
4 I SAID WITNESS LEE RUNS THE CHURCH WITH AN IRON HAND AND THAT
5 HE CONTROLS EVERYBODY AND MANIPULATES EVERYBODY BECAUSE WHAT
6 REALLY IS HAPPENING IS THERE IS CHAOS IN THE LOCAL CHURCH
7 AND THEY ARE ALL DOING THEIR OWN THING BECAUSE THEY ARE SPIRIT-
8 LED," SO HE IS BASICALLY CONTRADICTING HIS OWN SELF.

9 BUT WHAT THE POINT HE IS TRYING TO MAKE HERE IS THAT
10 WITNESS LEE HAS BUILT A THEOLOGY AND THE LOCAL CHURCH HAS
11 ACCEPTED A THEOLOGY WHERE INDIVIDUAL SPIRIT GUIDANCE IS THE
12 WAY YOU MAKE DECISIONS RATHER THAN APPLYING TO THE SCRIPTURE
13 FOR GUIDANCE.

14 Q IS HE SAYING THAT YOU REALLY DON'T REALIZE THAT YOU
15 ARE APPROVING IMMORAL ACTS, AS AN EXAMPLE?

16 A THAT'S RIGHT BECAUSE -- WELL, YOU ARE APPROVING ACTS
17 THAT YOU HAVE BEEN TAUGHT IN CHILDHOOD WERE IMMORAL BECAUSE
18 EVERYBODY IS A CONVERT BUT NOW THEY NO LONGER APPEAR IMMORAL
19 TO YOU BECAUSE YOU HAVE GOTTEN THE WORD FROM INSIDE YOURSELF
20 AND YOUR SPIRIT THAT WHAT YOU WANT TO DO IS OKAY.

21 Q NOW THIS IS FOLLOWING A STORY ABOUT A CHILD RAPE, IS IT
22 NOT?

23 A AS BEST AS I REMEMBER, IT IS.

24 Q SO IN EFFECT, THEN, MR. DUDDY IS SAYING THAT WITNESS
25 LEE'S TEACHING IN THIS REGARD BEARS SOME RESPONSIBILITY FOR
26 THIS CHILD RAPE, IS THAT CORRECT?

27 A IT WOULD FREE SOMEONE TO DO IMMORAL THINGS WITHOUT A
28 GUILTY CONSCIENCE.

1 Q ISN'T HE ALSO SAYING THAT THE PEOPLE IN THE CHURCH
2 AREN'T EVEN PREPARED TO DISCIPLINE ONE FOR THAT BECAUSE THEY
3 DON'T ACCEPT IT AS WRONG?

4 A THAT'S RIGHT.

5 Q AND THAT'S TOTALLY FALSE AS FAR AS WITNESS LEE AND THE
6 CHURCH, IS THAT RIGHT?

7 A TOTALLY FALSE.

8 Q AGAIN, IN YOUR OPINION, MAKING THIS KIND OF A CHARGE
9 AGAINST WITNESS LEE IN THE LOCAL CHURCH, WAS THIS SOMETHING
10 THAT HAD TO HAVE BEEN DELIBERATE?

11 A CERTAINLY THE CHARGE WAS DELIBERATE, AND TO CONNECT
12 IT WITH THESE TEACHINGS THAT IGNORE WHAT WITNESS LEE HAS SAID
13 ABOUT THE NECESSITY OF MEMBERS FOLLOWING THE LAW, IT EITHER
14 HAD TO BE DELIBERATE OR SOME KIND OF RECKLESS DISREGARD OF
15 WHAT HE HAD OBVIOUSLY SAID.

16 MR. MORGAN: IT IS NOONTIME. WHAT IS YOUR
17 PLEASURE, YOUR HONOR?

18 THE COURT: WHY DON'T WE TAKE A BREAK. 1:30?

19 MR. MORGAN: 1:30 IS FINE, YOUR HONOR.

20 YOUR HONOR, I MAY HAVE TO CALL A WITNESS OUT OF ORDER
21 WHEN I COME BACK, AS ONE OF THEM HAS TO CATCH AN AIRPLANE.

22 THE COURT: SURE. NO PROBLEM.

23 WE WILL ADJOURN, THEN, UNTIL 1:30.

24 (RECESS TAKEN.)

25 THE COURT: MR. MORGAN, YOU HAVE A WITNESS TO
26 TAKE OUT OF ORDER?

27 MR. MORGAN: YES, YOUR HONOR. I AM CALLING MR.
28 ROBECK AT THIS TIME, YOUR HONOR.
