

1       A.    That means I usually look at the manuscripts when  
2            they are turned in to see that what the editor has  
3            been doing is adequate.  So I'll read select  
4            passages.  I'll look at their formatting.  I'm  
5            looking at the -- how they impact the manuscript.  
6            And I do that on most manuscripts.

7                    So yes, in the sense of spot checking what was  
8            done, yes.  Checking what might, I don't know, what  
9            might have been done, you can't really do that.

10       Q.   Did you find the work adequate on the whole?

11       A.    Yes.

12       Q.    **Did you spot check Mr. Strohmer's edit of the**  
13            **introduction to the book?**

14       A.    I don't know if I did that particular section or  
15            not.

16       Q.    **Did you spot check his work on the appendix to the**  
17            **book?**

18       A.    It's unlikely that I did anything with the  
19            appendix.

20       Q.    **Really?  How come?**

21       A.    I don't generally read appendices.

22       Q.    **Who at Harvest House was responsible for reading**  
23            **the appendix?**

24       A.    **No one was responsible for reading the appendix.**

25       Q.    Would it be fair to say that no one at Harvest
