5 A. Yes.

6 **Q. Does Harvest House subject all of its**
7 **manuscripts to substantive editing?**

8 A. No.

9 **Q. Did Harvest House subject the Encyclopedia of**
10 **Cults and New Religions to substantive editing?**

11 A. No.

12 Q. All right. Does substantive editing,
13 particularly checking the structure and content, entail
14 checking statements of fact for their accuracy?

15 A. The editor would check -- probably check more
16 facts in a substantive edit.

17 Q. Why did Harvest House decide not to subject
18 the Encyclopedia of Cults and New Religions to a
19 substantive edit?

20 A. I don't know.

21 Q. Who made that decision?

22 A. That was Betty Fletcher, the managing editor.

23 Q. Do most Harvest House publications get a
24 substantive edit?

25 A. No.
